STAMP DUTIES AND COURT FEES

It is notified for general information that affidavits and statutory declarations should be stamped with the appropriate stamp duty ⁽¹⁾ before being presented to Officers of the Court for swearing or affirmation. ⁽¹⁾

2. Should a Court fee be prescribed, where the document is to be presented to other than a Court, such as an affidavit to the Collector of Estate Duty, ⁽²⁾ such fee should be paid before the affidavit is sworn or affirmed.
