REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 16/46

*PRICE CONTROL**

1. Price control is being instituted with the following objects:

- (i) To arrest and reduce the inflation which result from the black market which adversely affects the buying power of the dollar.
- (ii) To bring prices down to a reasonable level.

2. It is the duty therefore of every member of this Department to co-operate with the Price Control authorities by reporting all cases of overcharging or hoarding.

3. You are requested accordingly carefully to explain the terms of this circular to every member of your staff and to arrange that the staff be allowed to perform the duty now imposed on them, explaining to them that it is in their interest to co-operate with the Price Control officers so that the desired end may be achieved.

4. A copy of this circular together with Jawi translation should be posted where the staff may see it.
