REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 20/46

DOCUMENT FOR USE IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES

In some circumstances Magistrates are called

upon to administer oaths or to attest signatures on documents for use abroad. When such documents are designed for use in foreign countries, the signatures and seals of the Magistrates require legalisation by the Consuls of the foreign countries wherein the documents are intended to be used.

2. Where application is made to any Magistrate in these circumstances for a specimen of his signature and seal, such specimen should not be handed to a member of the public, but should be sent by the Magistrate direct to the foreign Consul under cover of an appropriately worded letter.
3. The Chief Justice directs accordingly.
