BAIL BONDS

Attention is drawn to the importance of ensuring that Bail Bonds are drawn in the form appropriately to the circumstances. (1) Owing to the shortage of paper it has been necessary to print as one form (Courts 123) a Bond which can be used in various circumstances, and that the correct particulars are inserted.

2. It must be borne in mind that if the circumstances become altered in any way a fresh bond must always be entered into. In particular, if any accused person has been on bail during the course of a Preliminary Enquiry and is committed for trial to the High Court then unless attendance in the High Court is already covered by the existing bond a fresh bond must be prepared and entered into if bail is granted. (2)
