REGISTERS OF POWERS OF ATTORNEY

In view of Practice Note No.1 issued by this Registry on the 26th June, 1946, it is requested that you take early action to collect from all the Magistrates in your State or Settlement all registers of powers of attorney and the deposited copies of the documents for permanent record.

2. The Chief Justice feels that the public should not be put to any disadvantage and therefore where any Magistrate has registered any Power of Attorney without due authority you will require to re-register as at the date of registration by the Magistrate in order to validate the acts of the attorney in the interim.
