*STAMP DUTY AND COURT FEES**

I have received complaints from the Collector of Estate Duty that in spite of Registrar's Circular No.12/46⁽¹⁾ the Court Fee is not being collected on Estate Duty affidavits at the time of affirmation and that the Collector has to enter into correspondence with Solicitors and deponents to collect the said Court Fee which takes up a considerable amount of his time. It would be appreciated, if the provisions of Registrar's Circular No. 12/46 are remembered and the appropriate Court Fee invariably collected before the Assistant Registrar, District Judge or Magistrate attests the signature of the deponent on any Estate Duty affidavit affirmed before him.
