REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO.2/47

RETURNS OF PROBATE AND  
LETTERS OF  
ADMINISTRATION

With effect from 1st January, 1947 the following practice should be adopted in submitting returns of Probate and Letters of Administration matters.

2. Each Assistant Registrar of the Supreme Court shown below should collect particulars of all petitions dealt with in the areas shown against each by the several Assistant Registrars (with powers limited to Administration matters) in the form annexed and should compile the said returns monthly, including figures for his own registry, and send a consolidated return to this Registry on or before the 10th of each succeeding month.
