REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 7/47

Affidavits and Statutory Declarations

Order 36 Rule 14 of the Straits Settlements Supreme Court Rules and the Rules of Court applicable in the Malay States made under the Courts Enactment (Cap.2) section 75(i) Rules 20 and 21 should be followed in the completion of affidavits. All alterations, interlineations and erasures should be authenticated by the initials of the officer taking the affidavit. Cases have been recently noted where these have not been so initialled. The jurat of each affidavit and statutory declaration should, in addition to being signed by the officer administering the oath or affirmation, be sealed with the official seal of such officer. (3)

Affidavits are not, without leave of the Court, admissible in evidence unless they are properly completed as above indicated. (3)
