

BINDING OF APPEAL RECORDS

Much inconvenience has recently been caused by inefficient binding of appeal records. Unless the record consists of only a few pages, stapling machines should not be used. The staples are not strong enough or long enough and they pull through or break and the record comes to pieces. All records (except very small ones) should be bound in book form with cord, tape, or strong string.
