Transport Expenses of Process Servers.

The charges for transport allowances for expenses of Process Servers are not a fair charge on Government, and the cost of service of process should therefore be borne by litigants who should pay any necessary mileage charges. If this is done there is no necessity for fixed bicycle allowances to Process Servers.

2. If any fixed bicycle allowance is paid by your Court or any mileage allowance which could be paid as above by litigants you should take steps to rectify the position at once. Any such payment made after the 1st March, 1948 will be queried and the explanation that they have been paid in the past will not be ^{accepted} ~~accepted~~ without further good grounds.
