REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 14/48

ASSIGNMENT OF COUNSEL IN CRIMINAL TRIALS AND APPEALS
IN EMERGENCY PROCEDURE CASES AS DEFINED IN EMERGENCY
(CRIMINAL TRIALS) REGULATIONS, 1948.

On the application of the Bar Council the Chief Justice hereby directs as follows:-

(A) TRIALS OF EMERGENCY PROCEDURE CASES.

Counsel should be assigned not less than 7 and not more than 10 days before the trial.

(B) APPEALS IN EMERGENCY PROCEDURE CASES.

(i) The Court of Appeal will sit in Kuala Lumpur every Thursday to hear appeals from convictions by the High Court in Emergency Procedure Cases. If any Thursday is a public holiday some other date will be fixed. Counsel should be assigned and furnished with a copy of the record on or before the previous Saturday.

(ii) Normally the Counsel assigned to conduct the appeal should be different from Counsel assigned to conduct the defence at the trial.
