REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO.6/49

EMERGENCY(CRIMINAL TRIALS)REGULATIONS 1948.

REGULATION 11.

With reference to circular letter of the 14th May, 1949, addressed to all Deputy Public Prosecutors by the Attorney-General on the subject of Judges in future being supplied by the prosecution with copies of statements of witnesses under the above mentioned Regulation (copies of that circular letter were sent to all Judges and Assistant Registrars), Assistant Registrars should note -

- (a) This in no way alters the procedure laid down in the Memorandum on Emergency Procedure issued to all Assistant Registrars on 15th July, 1948, as amended by Registrar's Circular No.2/49.
- (b) The Deputy Public Prosecutor and not the committing Magistrate will supply copies of statements under the above mentioned Regulation. On receipt of the copies of such statements the Assistant Registrar will hand them to the Secretary of the Judge who is to preside at the trial. The Judge's Secretary will enclose them in the Judge's copy of the Deposition folder (Cts.153)

B. Letter RSC.64/48 of 4.3.39, in reply to letter from the Assistant Registrar, Supreme Court, Ipoh, of 2.3.49 (Perak Criminal Trial 1/49), is hereby cancelled.
