REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 7/49

Appeal and Drawing up of Orders of Court of Appeal

Further to the instructions contained in Registrar's

Circular No. 18/48 of 30th December, 1948 the following instructions with regard to appeals and applications to the Court of Appeal should be carefully observed.

(a) Taxation of Bills of Costs on Appeal.

This work should be done by the Assistant Registrar of the Court where the Court of Appeal sat and heard the Appeal e.g. if a Seremban appeal is heard at Kuala Lumpur, the Assistant Registrar, Supreme Court, Kuala Lumpur will do the taxation. (1)

(b) Drawing up of Orders of Court of Appeal.

All orders will be signed and sealed by the Registrar of the Court of Appeal, Federation of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur only. Counsel having the carriage of the order should submit their drafts to the Registrar of the Court of Appeal, Federation of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur irrespective of the State or Settlement where the original proceeding was heard or where the appeal was heard. The draft order so submitted should bear the usual endorsement of the Solicitor for the opposite party.
