

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE FEDERATION OF MALAYA.REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO:11/50.Exemption of Fees for Statutory Declaration

An instance has come to my notice where an officer of this department in his capacity of Commissioner for Oaths appointed under the Commissioners for Oaths Ordinance, 1947, refused to grant exemption in accordance with Section 18 of the Post Office Savings Bank Ordinance, 1948, without a certificate of exemption from the State Treasurer. This procedure was, in the opinion of the Attorney-General, with which I agree, wrong.

2. A public officer requested to take a Declaration in these circumstances should observe the following procedure :-

- (i) satisfy himself that the Declaration is one which comes within the purview of Section 18 of the Post Office Savings Bank Ordinance, 1948;
- (ii) apply the provision in Section 2 of L.N. 56;
- (iii) affirm the Declaration, without charge.
