

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE FEDERATION OF MALAYA.REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO: 12/50.Power of Juvenile Courts.

Section 12(1)⁽¹⁾ of the Juvenile Courts Ordinance, 1947, sets out the powers of a Juvenile Court and these powers are "in addition to any other powers exercisable by virtue of this Ordinance or any other law for the time being in force."

2. If a Juvenile Court takes advantage of any power given to it outside the Ordinance, e.g. whipping, it appears that there is no column under which this could appear in the return "Particulars of charges proved and not proved and orders made in respect of Children and Young Persons" attached to Registrar's Circular No. 3/50, dated 16th February 1950.

3. This form is therefore amended by adding the words "or any other law" to the words "Orders made under Sec.36" which appear in the last column. If the figure under this column includes any orders made under any power outside the Ordinance it should be asterisked and particulars of them should be given below.
