CRIMINAL FEES.

It appears that certain Courts are taking a fee in respect of a complaint or information for warrants or summons under Section 155 (1) of the F.M.S. Criminal Procedure Code or under Section 143 of the S.S. Criminal Procedure Code. The authority for taking the fee is said to be Item 33 of the Subordinate Courts Rule No.1 of 1948.

2. In my opinion no fee should be payable. Therefore, for the sake of uniformity all Courts from the date of this circular shall cease to charge any fee whatever practice may have been observed formerly.
