Service of Notice of Appeal
by the Public Prosecutor

A case recently occurred in one of the lower Courts in which the Public Prosecutor gave notice of appeal against the Court's decision. Unfortunately certain delays occurred with regard to the preparation of the Appeal Record and no attempt was therefore made to serve the Respondent with the Record of Appeal until some three months after the date of the notice of appeal.

2. It was then discovered that the Respondent had left the country a month earlier having no knowledge that any appeal had been lodged in this case.

3. By agreement with the Office of the Attorney-General it has been agreed that in future when the Public Prosecutor gives notice of appeal against the decision of any of the lower Courts he will forward an extra copy or copies of the Notice which the Court in question can serve on the respondent or Respondents.

4. Therefore, in future, all Sessions Courts and Magistrates' Courts when the Public Prosecutor appeals against one of their decisions will have served the extra copy or copies supplied by the Public Prosecutor on the Respondent or Respondents as soon as possible.
