

REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO: 1/51.

Certification fee for Copy of Will in Grant of Probate

A reference has been made to me by a Senior Assistant Registrar as to whether a certification fee is payable under 1948 Rule 9 items 18 and 20 on the true copy of a Will which is included in a Grant of Probate.

No certification fee should be charged.
The correct fees chargeable are as under:

- (a) Item 30 will apply in respect of an issue copy of a Grant of Probate, that is to say, no certification fee is recoverable on a true copy of the Will or Codicil, so certified, attached to the issue copy of a Grant of Probate.
- (b) When, however, a true copy of a Grant of Probate is supplied, the whole document will come under one of the items 18, 19 or 20 as the case may be and fee is recoverable as laid down in these items.
