REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 4/51.

Contributions of Parents or Guardians

It has been agreed that the following procedure shall be adopted with regard to contributions ordered to be made by a parent or guardian under section 34 of the Juvenile Courts Ordinance, 1947.

2. When the contribution is paid into Court a receipt will be given by the Court Clerk and it will be entered into the Court Cash Book. The money received will be paid into the Treasury under Item 139 "School Fees".
3. Any contributions already received by any Court which have been kept on deposit should now be withdrawn and credited to revenue under Item 139 aforesaid.
4. When any parent or guardian defaults in payment of any contribution the Court Probation Officer will be informed when he can decide whether to apply for a summons against the person defaulting.
