An observation has been received from the Audit Department that green ink has been used in signing summaries of cases, cash books etc.

2. Since green ink has been used by the Audit Department for a number of years they have by long usage and tacit consent established an exclusive claim to the use of green ink.

3. All addressees therefore are requested kindly to discontinue the use of green ink or pencil on official documents if that has been their practice and others are requested not to adopt the use of green ink or pencil in the future.
