REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 3 OF 1955.

PAYMENT OF TRANSLATION
FEES BY TREASURY

In a recent instance the amount of 50% translation fees due to Interpreters for translations done in accordance with para 5 of Chap. IX of "The Fees (Public Officers) Regulations 1953" was not paid for one year but was allowed to be accumulated for the year 1954 and was submitted recently for payment from 1955 Votes. Action has therefore to be taken under F.G.O. 47 to obtain sanction from Accountant General to pay it from 1955 Votes.

2. This has caused difficulties and additional work to this Registry and inconvenience to the Treasury. In addition it is a strain on my 1955 Votes. Moreover, it is necessary to put up explanation when application is made under F.G.O.47 and if this explanation is not very satisfactory the application might be refused and in that event the Interpreters concerned stand to lose the amounts due to them.

3. To avoid all these you are requested to see that vouchers for all translations fees due to be refunded to the Interpreters for translations done during one month should be submitted to this Registry without fail during the succeeding month.
