REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 8 OF 1955.

MAINTENANCE ORDERS - APPROVED SCHOOLS

The Chief Social Welfare Officer has informed me that in certain Courts there is a tendency for the accumulation of arrears under Maintenance Orders made by Courts under Section 34 of the Juvenile Courts Ordinance 1947, and that, at times, the Probation Officer is not informed of non-payment, as required by Registrar's Circular No.4/51.

2. It has been arranged that the Probation Officer in each State or Settlement shall keep a record of these payments, and, in order to provide for this, the following procedure must be followed. The officer making out the receipt for any such payment must, at the time of preparing the receipt send a memo to the Probation Officer in the following form :-
