
Circular to Senior Assistant Registrars, Assistant Registrars, and Magistrates (in their capacity as Assistant Registrars).

PROBATE & ADMINISTRATION JURISDICTION.

Certain Courts are still sending in to the Central Registry the notices of application prescribed by Rule 47 of the F.M.S. "Rules for non-contentious business in the Supreme Court in its probate jurisdiction" (Vol I Rules under F.M.S. Enactments p. 27). The forms used are Nos. 3 and 4 in the Schedule to the Rules.

2. The sending in of these notices is now unnecessary and can be discontinued. The "Blue Card" system which was inaugurated in 1950 has rendered them obsolete.

3. The above mentioned Rules will be repealed when new legislation now being drafted is brought into force.
