REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 2 OF 1958

Record of Previous Convictions.

The Honourable the Chief Justice has directed that in every case where previous convictions are proved against an accused person, who subsequently appeals, the appeal record must contain full details of such convictions - (date, Court, offence, sentence).

2. In the case of trials in the High Court, if the Judge does not make a note of such details, then a copy of the list as read out to and admitted by the accused must be certified by the Registrar and included in the record.
