REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO: 1 OF 1960.

Criminal Appeals to the Court of Appeal in cases involving a Sentence of Death

Where an Appeal against a death sentence has been dismissed by the Court of Appeal you should ensure that, subsequent to such dismissal, the following practice is strictly and consistently observed:-

- (i) A copy of the Order made by the Ruler, whether in confirmation or commutation of sentence of death, must be forwarded to this Registry as soon as the Order is received in your Registry.
- (ii) The date and time fixed under the "Warrant of Execution on a Sentence of Death" must be notified to this Registry as soon as the warrant is issued.
- (iii) This Registry must be informed as soon as you are notified that the sentence of death has been carried out.

2. Compliance with the above instructions is essential in order to enable the above information to be promptly laid before the Honourable the Chief Justice in every case. Besides, the above information is also required for the adequate maintenance of the Records in this Registry and for the compilation of returns which are required to be submitted from this Registry to the Ministry of Justice.
