Attendance in Court by Chemists, Department of  
Chemistry and the Document Examiner,  
Federation of Malaya

The Chief Justice directs that in view of the shortage of Chemists in the Department of Chemistry and there being only one gazetted Document Examiner in the Federation of Malaya, these experts, whenever they are subpoenaed to give evidence in Court, should, as far as possible, be called at a specified time and released as soon as possible after they have given evidence, so as to avoid their being kept waiting unnecessarily.
