REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO: 1 OF 1962

Withdrawal of Court Deposits

It has been agreed with the Accountant-General and the Auditor-General that a voucher in form "Fin.270" or "Fin.48" for the payment out of money on deposit in Court need not be supported by the form "Courts 162", provided it is made clear on the voucher in either form that such payment out is made in pursuance of an order of Court in the relevant proceedings or in accordance with the Rules of Court.

2. The use of form "Courts 162" must therefore be discontinued forthwith. For the sake of uniformity either of the following endorsements must be made in the body of the appropriate voucher under the heading "Detail of Supply or Particulars of Service":

(a) "Payment out of money on deposit in Court in pursuance of an order of Court dated the day of, 19... Deposit Receipt No:"

(b) "Payment out of money on deposit in Court in accordance with the Rules of Court. Deposit Receipt No:"

3. It will be observed that endorsement (a) as set out in the last paragraph will be required only if there is a formal order of Court. In the vast majority of cases, however, the money is paid out on a direction by the appropriate officer of the Court without a formal order made in the relevant Court proceedings. In all such cases endorsement (b) as set out in the last paragraph will suffice.

4. Registrar's Circular No.4 of 1960 is hereby cancelled.
