REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO: 7 OF 1970.

Further to Registrar's Circular No: 5 of 1970 dated 27th August, 1970, it is hereby directed that all Senior Assistant Registrars/Assistant Registrars of the High Courts do transfer immediately (if this has not been done) all pending civil cases triable by Sessions Court including claims involved exceeding \$2,000/- but not \$5,000/- to the Sessions Courts as prescribed in the Schedule hereunder. A Return showing the type and total number of cases so transferred should be sent to this Registry by the end of October, 1970. Fresh cases triable by Sessions Court must of course be accepted for filing in all Sessions Courts.

2. When transferring cases to the Sessions Courts, it is suggested that the parties should be notified as in the Form attached herewith.

3. On receipt of the cases from the High Court, the President, Sessions Court concerned or his Registrar shall cause them to be registered and notify the parties of the date of mention or hearing as the case may be.
